

## WORKSHOP I – 1:00 – 2:30 PM



- 1 **Big Clipper**  
Paint a giant 6” wooden clothes pin. A great holder for recipe cards, photos or coupons.

Bring: All supplies provided.
- 2 **Braided Table Mat**  
Make a braided table mat, approximately 8” in diameter. Cotton cording is covered in fabric, then sewn. It is an addictive process to watch the colors flow together. (*Fabrics may vary from sample.*)

Bring: Scissors, glue stick (fabric). Sewing machine (good working order, able to do a zigzag stitch.)
- 3 **Holiday Buttons**  
A festive arrangement filled with fresh greenery, buttons, a bow and a candle.

Bring: Clippers to cut greens.
- 4 **Holiday Table Runner X 2**  
Use flip & sew technique to machine quilt a reversible 18 x 42 inch table runner. Side 1 has a holiday theme, side 2 a winter theme. Fabrics may vary. (*This is a 2 hr. class and will continue into Workshop II*)

- 5 **Knitted Dish Cloth**  
Knitted dish cloth for beginners. Learn to: cast on, knit, purl, and bind off. Yarns will vary.
